Saved by how much?







6 min/trip = 40 hrs/yr = 1 week 80 MM hrs/yr region wide



Average Savings of Travel Time Resulting from Modifying Behavior

- Shifting departure time: 20.4%
- Changing only route: 21.9%
- Changing both route & departure time : 20.9% savings
- Departing earlier saved: 18.5%
- Departing later saved : 20.6%
- AM commutes saved: 27%
- PM commutes saved: 15.1%





El Paso Regional Benefits

- Reduce congestion on El Paso road network and manage capacity
- Ability to directly communicate with system user
- Manage capacity throughout region (increase efficiencies out of the existing infrastructure)
- Promote local business
- Increase future Border Highway West Express Lane utilization and overall capacity utilization
- Potential to improve air quality
- Identify potential opportunities to enhance border crossing operations and improve the effectiveness of the regional incident management program
- Potential to improve multi-modal choices in the El Paso region (further contributing to improved congestion and air quality)






