WHEREAS, the City of El Paso (City), El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and the Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority (CRRMA) previously executed an interlocal agreement, whereby the various agencies agreed to provide funding to the CRRMA and the CRRMA would be responsible for the development, implementation and operation of a bike share program within the El Paso region with a total budget of \$2,000,000 (the "Bike Share Program"); and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Policy Board of the MPO took action of November 1, 2013, to reduce the Bike Share Program budget to \$720,000 and therefore, the Parties now desire to amend the Interlocal Agreement to reflect such change; and

WHEREAS, the parties believe that the Bike Share Program will still provide additional mobility options in and around downtown El Paso and the surrounding neighborhoods, among other areas, and the City and MPO continue to desire to provide partial funding for the Bike Share Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAMINO REAL REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY:

THAT the Executive Director be authorized to execute a First Amendment to an Interlocal Agreement with the El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization (EPMPO) and the City of El Paso (City), which amends the project budget for Phase I of the Bike Share Program contemplated for the El Paso region.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

This **FIRST AMENDMENT TO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT** ("Amendment") is entered into by and between the **CITY OF EL PASO**, **TEXAS** ("City"), the **EL PASO METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION** ("MPO"), and the **CAMINO REAL REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY** ("CRRMA"), a political subdivision of the State of Texas (the CRRMA, City, and MPO hereafter collectively referred to as the "Parties").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Interlocal Agreement with an Effective Date of July 15, 2013 (the "Interlocal Agreement") for the funding and development of a Bike Share Program in El Paso (the "Bike Share Program"), whereby the City and MPO would provide partial funding for the program and the CRRMA would administer such program; and

WHEREAS, per the Interlocal Agreement, the original Bike Share Program included a \$2,000,000 total project budget, as approved by the MPO; and

WHEREAS, through MPO action of November 1, 2013, the Bike Share Program budget was reduced to \$720,000 and therefore, the Parties now desire to amend the Interlocal Agreement to reflect such change.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and on behalf of the general public good and the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the undersigned Parties agree as follows:

I. FINDINGS

Recitals. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein for all purposes and are found by the Parties to be true and correct. It is further found and determined that the Parties have authorized and approved this Agreement by their respective entities, and that this Agreement will be in full force and effect when executed by all Parties.

II. AMENDMENTS TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

- 1. Amendment to EXHIBIT "A". The parties hereby agree to delete EXHIBIT "A" in its entirety and replace it with EXHIBIT "A-1", which is attached hereto.
- **2. Ratification**. Except as expressly amended by this Amendment, the Interlocal Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. No other rights, interests and obligations existing and to exist under the Interlocal Agreement are hereby released, diminished or impaired,

and the Parties hereby reaffirm all covenants, representations, obligations and agreements in the Interlocal Agreement as originally executed.

EXHIBIT "A-1"

EL PASO BIKE SHARE PROGRAM PROPOSED SCOPE & BUDGET

The proposed scope of this project includes the development, installation, marketing, operation, and maintenance of a Bike Share Program with stations at various locations in the City of El Paso. The general area of the proposed bike stations could include locations in downtown El Paso, the greater downtown area, UTEP and its surrounding neighborhoods and other areas agreed to by the stakeholders. Actual locations shall be determined throughout the project process in coordination with project stakeholders. The number of bikes and stations procured through this process shall be determined by the project budget and through coordination with the project vendor and stakeholders. Global Positioning Systems (GPS) may be used to calculate bicycle miles traveled and GPS units may be attached to the bicycles. The CRRMA intends to include a bicycle safety awareness program in the program's marketing efforts.
