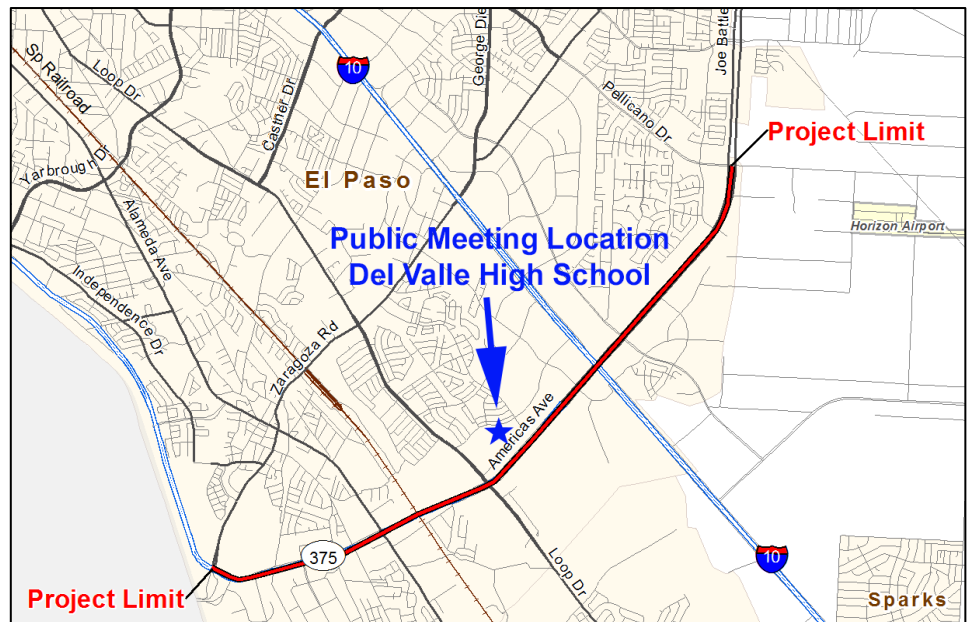

The public meeting will be conducted in an open-house format. Those wishing to attend are encouraged to do so at their convenience between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. Maps of the project study area and other displays will be available for review and comment. Project staff will be available to answer questions. All handouts will be presented in English and Spanish. Free parking will be available in the school parking lot.



The purpose of the meeting is to provide information about the proposed project and gather input from the public. The proposed project consists of constructing two lanes (one in each direction) in the center median of the existing four-lane divided, limited access facility. All or a portion of the new lanes could be tolled (also known as “managed”) lanes and could connect the new lanes to the recently constructed managed lanes on the Loop 375 Southern Corridor (César Chávez) from United States Highway (US) 54 to Zaragoza Road. The project may also include adding frontage road bridges over major arterials (including the Union Pacific Rail Road) and extending frontage roads between Alameda Avenue and Farm-to-Market Road 76 (North Loop Drive) where no frontage roads exist. The project study area extends from Zaragoza Road to Pellicano Drive. All of the proposed work is proposed to occur within existing TxDOT right-of-way.
