

SUPPLEMENTAL WORK AUTHORIZATION NO. 9B

This **Supplemental Work Authorization No. 9B** is made as of this 3rd day of June, 2013, under the terms and conditions established in the AGREEMENT FOR GENERAL CONSULTING ENGINEERING SERVICES, dated as of January 16, 2009 (the "Agreement") and the WORK AUTHORIZATION NO. 9 dated September 8, 2011 (the "WA#9"), both agreements being by and between the Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority ("Authority") and Atkins North America, Inc. formerly known as Post, Buckley, Schuh & Jernigan, Inc. ("GEC"). This **Supplemental Work Authorization No. 9B** is made for the purposes identified below, consistent with the services defined in the Agreement.

This **Supplemental Work Authorization No. 9B** is intended to provide general engineering and related services from the GEC to the Authority on an as-needed basis as identified by the Executive Director of the Authority from time to time in a total cumulative amount not to exceed \$10,000.00. This **Supplemental Work Authorization No. 9B** is being issued pursuant to WA#9 at the sole discretion of the CRRMA and no work is guaranteed to the GEC by the execution of this **Supplemental Work Authorization No. 9B**.

Therefore and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreement between the parties, the Authority and GEC hereby agree to the following.

Section A. – Scope of Services

The GEC shall provide various general engineering support and related services to the Authority as more fully enumerated within **EXHIBIT "A"**, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section B. – Schedule

The GEC shall provide such engineering and related services to the Authority as requested from time to time by the Executive Director of the Authority. The period of performance shall commence upon the request of the Executive Director of any particular task and shall continue for a period to be agreed upon by the Executive Director and the GEC, dependent upon the nature of the services requested.


Section C. – Compensation


The total cumulative compensation for services requested by the Authority pursuant to this **Supplemental Work Authorization No. 9B** shall not exceed TEN THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$10,000.00), subject to and in accordance with the Fee Summary dated May 24, 2013, which is attached to and incorporated herein as **EXHIBIT "B"**. The fees included in **EXHIBIT "B"** are based on the hourly rates and other charges established within the Agreement. Compensation shall be made in accordance with the Agreement. Invoices shall be provided by the GEC in accordance with the requirements enumerated within WA#9.

Except to the extent expressly modified herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement and WA#9 shall continue in full force and effect.
