Procurement Summary

- On July 11, 2012, the RFQ for environmental and preliminary engineering was released.
- The RFQ was posted to the CRRMA website on July 11, 2012.
- A Notice of Issuance of the RFQ was published in the July 20 publication of the Texas Register (Volume 37, Number 29).
- A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 6% was established for the project.
- A total of five Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) were received in response to the RFQ on August 2, 2012.
- The five teams were comprised of the following primes, subconsultants, and disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE) firms.
