Purpose of the IDC Procurement

- The intent of this IDC procurement is to develop a list of preapproved professional engineering firms that will be available to the CRRMA to develop various projects, on an as-needed basis.
- This procurement seeks various types of professional services, including examples like:
 - Surveying;
 - Right-of-way Mapping;
 - Schematic Design;
 - Environmental Studies;
 - Public Involvement Activities;
 - Plans, Specifications, and Estimates; and
 - Project Management and Administration.

Scoring Criteria

Team Organization, Staffing and DBE 30%

Review of firm and staff qualifications, relevance of experience, knowledge of regional setting/projects, organization, size, structure and location of proposed staff members as it relates to potential responsiveness

Past Project Experience 25%

Review of relevance of experience, prior similar projects, knowledge of regional setting, projects and affected agencies

Project Understanding and Approach 35%

Review of demonstrated understanding of services requested, clearly defined strategies and innovative approaches to provide such services

Project Schedule

<u>10%</u>

Presented a project schedule identifying all major activities/events required and a clear and reasonable plan to meet such schedule

Selection Committee Recommendation

The Selection Committee met and reviewed each of the ten (10) submittals and developed the unanimous recommendation that the CRRMA Board select the <u>top five scoring IDC submittals</u>. The recommendation for the selection of five firms was based on the large gap in scores between the top five and bottom five ranked firms.
