SunCycle Performance Report - Program Highlights



- Q1 is September, October, and November
- Trips increased from 2,322 in FY 23 to 2,818, or 21%
- November 24th produced most trips in a single day since summer 2021
- Schuster construction continues to impact UTEP and surrounding stations
- Uptick in memberships (month, semester, annual) compared to same period prior year
- Destination El Paso organized M&I Trade Show Group ride in early October (special rides are not reflected in checkout counts)
- San Jacinto Plaza and Arts Festival Plaza remain the busiest stations but we observed upticks at some downtown stations




SunCycle Q1 Ridership

SunCycle Performance Report - Operational Update



- Continue work reconfiguring our station deployment outside of our current footprint to engage and attract potential customers who do not visit our current locations
 - Application to International Boundary & Water Commission
 - County approved location at Ascarate Park with access to the PDN Trail
 - Installed December 14th
 - Planning a launch event/group ride to raise awareness
- Bcycle's software fee increasing 5% on 4/1/2024
- TxDOT is drafting the TASA Grant Advanced Funding Agreement that will provide the CRRMA with access to \$100,000 towards the purchase of new e-bikes
 - Requires match of \$25,000
 - Allows CRRMA to upgrade aging fleet to new e-bikes at fraction of the cost
