WHEREAS, the County desires that a portion of those additional services be funded through its Vehicle Registration Fee (VRF) program and now seeks to amend the interlocal agreement to allow for the use of VRF bond proceeds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAMINO REAL REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY:

THAT the Chair of the CRRMA is authorized to execute a second amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with the County of El Paso, Texas to clarify the CRRMA's ability to utilize vehicle registration fee bond funds for the Bob Hope Drive Extension Project.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Interlocal Agreement – Project Development Agreement for the Bob Hope Drive Extension Project dated February 1, 2021 as amended by Amendment No. 1 dated January 22, 2023 (collectively the "Interlocal Agreement"), which provided funds necessary for the design of certain improvements to Bob Hope Drive, including the acquisition of certain rights of way (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to further amend the Interlocal Agreement in order to clarify the funding sources being provided by the County to the Authority for the services requested for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the undersigned Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Replacement of EXHIBIT C-1. The Parties hereby agree to delete EXHIBIT C-1 from the Interlocal Agreement in its entirety and replace it with EXHIBIT C-2, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.
- **2. Ratification.** Except as expressly amended by this Amendment, the Interlocal Agreement and its exhibits shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. Execution in Counterparts. This Amendment may be simultaneously executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original and all of which shall be considered fully executed as of the date first written above, when both Parties have executed an identical counterpart, notwithstanding that all signatures may not appear on the same counterpart.

- 2. The categories identified above are inclusive of design, acquisition, and administrative costs; provided, however, that Authority administrative costs for design shall not exceed 3% of the total project cost.
- 3. The authority granted by the County for the Authority's use of VRF funds anticipates the use of the 2014 or 2017 VRF bond proceeds. However, the CRRMA is also permitted to utilize 2014 or 2017 VRF General Funds, as necessary.
