#### **EXHIBIT B-3**

#### SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY THE ENGINEER

#### I. PROJECT SUMMARY OF SUPPLEMENTAL SCOPE

Additional professional services have been requested by the CRRMA to provide design services during construction (DSDC) for the Valley Chile Road Reconstruction Project for the construction of the water and wastewater improvements.

#### II. SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY THE ENGINEER

This task will be limited Construction Phase Services the Valley Chile Water and Wastewater Improvements designed by Parkhill. Inspection services will not be provided. The Scope of Services to be provided by the Engineer includes the following key elements:

#### A. Project Management and Administration

The project management and administration tasks shall include:

## 1. Progress Reporting

- a. Prepare and submit to the CRRMA monthly progress reports of activities competed during reporting period.
- b. Prepare and Submit invoices. The report shall be submitted as an attachment to the invoice submittal.

#### **B. DSDC Admin Services**

#### 1. Submittals

a. Maintain a log of submittals received and processed

#### 2. Attend Meetings

- a. Attend meetings as requested by the CRRMA and maintain notes for meeting items for reference.
- b. Make periodic Field Visits during construction as requested by the CRRMA.

#### C. Construction Phase Services

- 1. Provide services to include consulting with the Owner on resolutions of problems due to actual field conditions encountered; and reviewing shop drawings and submittals from Contractor for compliance with design concepts.
- 2. Provide the following support services:
  - a. Attend pre-construction meeting and weekly construction meetings as needed.

- b. Make periodic visits to project site at intervals appropriate to various stages of construction to observe the quality of the executed work and report to Owner.
- c. Issue responses to RFIs.
- d. Provide construction administration.
- e. Coordinate Owner during construction.
- f. Review and approve shop drawings and submittals.
- g. Review Contractor's construction schedules.
- h. Work with the Contractor and Owner to resolve design related construction problems.
- i. Make necessary interpretations and clarifications of Contract Documents.
- j. Parkhill will <u>subsequently</u> negotiate the cost of each Work Order and incorporate such changes into a proposed Change Order, with appropriate documentation attached, for Owner's written acceptance.

Parkhill is not authorized to commit to a final price or time extension without the written acceptance of the Owner in the form of a Change Order. A cost-price analysis shall be submitted with the proposed Change Order. When outside funding agencies are involved, they review and approve change orders for the following: Eligibility of funding; cost-price analysis; compliance with state design criteria; and environmental determination.

- k. Review and provide decisions as to suitability of work to Owner.
- 1. Provide substantial completion inspection walk-through of each project.
- m. Issue Engineer's Certificate of Substantial Completion, including punch list items and all other closeout requirements, to Owner for signature.
- n. Perform final inspection of project, recommend acceptance; and provide Engineer's Certificate of Final Completion, along with a complete closeout package to Owner. Prepare and submit to the Owner an evaluation of Contractor's performance on the project.
- o. Using Contractor redlines, as part of final closeout package, provide for Owner a set of record drawings and on CADD CD ROM.
- 3. Conduct a warranty inspection of the project within 30 days before end of one year from the date of Substantial Completion and submit a written report to Owner. Outside funding agencies may require a Certification of Project Performance.
