

**CAMINO REAL REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY

**WHEREAS**, the El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization (EPMPO) and the Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority (CRRMA) executed an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) whereby the CRRMA is providing funding, through El Paso County’s Vehicle Registration Fee program, to the EPMPO for development of its International Border Crossing Strategic Plan (Plan); and

**WHEREAS**, the federal requirements necessary to begin implementation of the Plan were delayed, the EPMPO has requested an extension of the termination date identified in the ILA, and the County is supportive of such an extension; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties now desire to execute an amendment to the ILA to extend the termination date originally included in that ILA.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAMINO REAL REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY:**

**THAT** the Executive Director of the CRRMA is authorized to execute a First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with the El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization for the development of the International Border Crossing Strategic Plan.

**FIRST AMENDMENT  
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT**

This First Amendment (“Amendment”) to the Interlocal Agreement dated October 14, 2024 (“Agreement”) is made and entered into as of the last date noted below by and between the El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization (“EPMPO”) and the Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority (“CRRMA”), collectively referred to as the “Parties.”

**WHEREAS**, the Parties entered into the Agreement for the CRRMA to provide local match funding to the EPMPO for the development of the International Border Crossing Strategic Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Paragraph 3 of the Agreement provides that the term of the Agreement shall remain in effect until completion of the Project on or before May 31, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desire to extend the termination date of the Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the promises, covenants, and other good and valuable consideration exchanged between the Parties, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Paragraph 3 of the Agreement is hereby amended to extend the termination date from May 31, 2026 to July 31, 2027.
2. Except as expressly amended herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
3. This Amendment shall become effective upon execution by both Parties.
