

CAMINO REAL REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY BOARD RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, House Bill 3834 from the 86th Texas Legislature enacted certain cyber security training requirements on the staff of local governments, including the Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority (CRRMA); and

WHEREAS, HB 3834 requires local governments to certify to the Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) that the local government’s staff has completed DIR approved training, in compliance with HB 3834; and

WHEREAS, DIR has developed an online submission process and a Governing Board Acknowledgement Form for local governments to certify compliance and the CRRMA desires now to complete such process in advance of the June 15 deadline required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAMINO REAL REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY:

THAT the Chair be authorized to execute a Governing Board Acknowledgement form, as it relates to the CRRMA’s completion of the required Security Awareness Training; and

THAT the Executive Director be authorized to submit the Security Awareness Training Certification to the Texas Department of Information Resources pursuant to and in accordance with all applicable laws of the State of Texas.
